# PBS Engagement Strategies

### Teacher should:

- Start the day with a celebration for every child and greet by name
- Use humour (not sarcasm)
- Be polite & smile
- Have enthusiasm

## Teacher options:

- Use praise and encouragement
- Ensure there is a ratio of 4:1 reinforcements to corrections
- Teach expected behaviours
- Provide specific and detailed feedback
- Focus on student contribution
- Pick your battles/planned ignore
- Proximity
- Minimal verbal

# Teacher options:

- Student re-enters class with a fresh start
- Focus on effort and improvement
- Private dialogue
- Ensure there is a ratio of 4:1 reinforcements to corrections
- Re-teach expected behaviours
- Provide specific and detailed feedback

- student and family
- entry meeting
- Implement IBP in class
- Use teacher options listed above as soon as student returns to class

# Levels of Behaviour

# **Encouraged behaviours**

Are outlined using the:

- Behaviour Expectation Matrix
- Classroom Agreements
- PBS School Signs

## Low Risk Behaviours

#### Students:

- Not completing/destroying their work
- Leaving the classroom (in sight of teacher)
- Running around in the classroom
- Attention seeking
- Not following instructions (x2)
- Not staying on task
- Feeling 'slack'
- Refusing help to complete work
- Swearing accidently
- Teasina
- Using phone

#### Moderate Risk Behaviours

#### Students:

- Swearing at other students
- Running out of class
- Not following instructions (x3)
- Back chatting staff
- Consistently disrupting other students

# **Teacher Responses**

## Refer to positive rewards systems

- Gotchas
- Merit certificates

# **Staff Responsible**

- Classroom Teachers
- Playground Duty Staff

## Teacher options:

- Visual reward & consequence charts
- Detention at lunch/fruit break
- Phones handed into office 'You see it, you take it'
- Teacher phones or visits family for consistent Low Risk behaviour
- Consider developing an Individual Behaviour Plan (IBP)
- Teach students self-regulation
- Pass given for Shooting Stars/Clontarf

- To be managed by the Classroom Teacher in the classroom
- Does **not** result in withdrawal, buddy class or suspension
- No involvement of Admin team required

# Teacher options:

- Detention at lunch/fruit break
- Reset Class
- Teacher to inform parent of behaviour
- Teacher to complete SIS entry
- Consider developing IBP

- To be managed by Classroom Teacher
- More support may be required from Cluster Team or Admin for withdrawal from class/buddy class

# Teacher and Admin actions:

- Complete re-entry meeting with
- Present IBP to student and family at re-

# **High Risk Behaviours**

#### Students:

- Throwing objects in class or at others
- · Running out of the school grounds or in an unsafe location
- Fighting/hitting/biting/kicking
- Swearing directly at staff members
- Breaking/damaging school property during school hours
- Verbally or physically intimidating staff or
- Not following instructions (x4)

# Teacher actions:

- Inform Admin and seek their assistance
- Use AIEO/EAs for cultural consultation
- Teacher to complete SIS entry
- Admin follow up SIS entry with withdrawal/suspension
- · Inform family of child's behaviour
- Teacher and Admin develop IBP

- · To be managed by Administration staff and Classroom Teacher
- Students on behaviour plans will follow appropriate actions, individualised to their needs.
